

**UNION MEMBERSHIP** protects you in the working life. As a member, you are not left alone when you need help or advice. You have the support of our community of 116,000 members.

OAJ members are professionals in the fields of education, training and research, ranging from early childhood education to adult education and training. The Trade Union of Education in Finland (OAJ) protects the interests of its members. Out of the Finnish trade unions, OAJ is the only one to negotiate the conditions of teachers' employment relationships. Our high unionisation rate guarantees that the union is heard when it comes to education-related decision making. The values of fairness, openness and responsibility direct our operations.

Advocacy is your most important membership benefit. Our network of shop stewards, union operators, occupational safety and health representatives and other specialists supports the members also in difficult situations. There are numerous other benefits as well.

The Trade Union of Education in Finland OAJ is the professional organisation for those working in the fields of education, training, and research. Together we are more.

**OAJ NEGOTIATES** matters related to salary, working hours, and other conditions related to the employment relationships of education professionals. OAJ's most important duties include securing and developing the terms of employment relationships as well as overseeing that the agreed terms of employment relationship are adhered to all around Finland.

Collective bargaining advocacy includes supervision of the functionality of the members' pay and working time systems. We advise and train shop stewards and answer our members' questions. We inform members about the payment of wages, working hours, study leave, or family leave as well as job search and resignation, for instance.

OAJ defends the position of its members in the event of temporary layoffs or cutting down of resources. Without a united, strong and large opposing side, the employer can easily demand different kinds of things. OAJ's members are supported by their local shop stewards and, if necessary, the experts of labour market advocacy working at the OAJ office. **THERE ARE** surprising working-life situations where advice and security are needed. OAJ has industry experts in local, regional and national levels working to protect its members. Reach out to your contact teacher or local association to find out who your shop steward and occupational safety and health representative are. OAJ experts also advise union members regarding their questions.

The employer is responsible for ensuring the health and safety, equality and occupational well-being of the personnel's working environment. The employee, on the other hand, is responsible for notifying their supervisor if they detect any shortcomings in the working conditions or face violent or threatening situations at work. In such an event, it is important to notify your own occupational safety and health representative to receive guidance and support.

After an incident, it is important to submit a notification as soon as possible. More information about occupational health and safety and instructions for submitting an OSH notification can be obtained from the OSH guide on the OAJ website.

Teachers' Unemployment Fund membership is included in the union fee of OAJ. Staff at the Teachers' Unemployment Fund are experts on the special features of the field of education and training.

# Professional legal protection

**THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION** or school is responsible for the psychological and physical safety of the study environment.

In the event of an accident, fingers are usually first pointed at teachers and principals. Parents are usually not directly demanding for the teacher to be sentenced; however, they might take the case to court in order to demand compensation. The court decides whether a person is guilty or not and bases its verdict largely on evidence.

In cases of serious damage, the consequences for the teacher might include termination of their employment contract, receiving a warning, having to pay for damages or being sentenced with criminal sanctions. The liability for damages usually falls on the education organiser, meaning that the damages are primarily paid by the employer.

After completing six months of membership, the members of OAJ have valid legal expenses insurance that recompenses the member's own legal costs and those of their opposing party in court cases related to working in the field of education in line with the terms of insurance.

Our legal services also provide advice for other legal questions related to education work, such as matters related to teacher's responsibilities and copyright.

**OAJ'S OBJECTIVE** is to make Finland the best place in the world to teach, learn, and do research. We impact education policies in many different ways in order to reach this goal.

Education policy impacting slightly differs from labour market policy impacting in that OAJ is not a negotiating party and impacts decision making right at the preparation stage. We highlight the concerns and observations of teachers and promote their position when education reforms are being carried out. The voices of our members are important in this work. Through OAJ, the members have their voices heard in the decision-making related to their work.

In Finland, several same objectives are often shared by different parties when developing education policies. However, OAJ is the only operator defending the position of education professionals in matters related to reforms.

Our reform-related objectives are for teachers to always have enough resources and to get to keep their jobs. For instance, OAJ has impacted the decrees of the Act on Early Childhood Education and Care related to the necessary number of teachers and the competences required for teachers in the professional reform.

OAJ is a significant education policy impactor that is recognised internationally as well. The union's broad member base provides it with significant authority at the decision-making tables. Due to its responsible advocacy work, OAJ is regarded as a trustworthy operator. This helps our members' voices to be better heard when deciding for matters related to Finnish education, training and research.

**OAJ'S TRAINING** promotes the advocacy skills of those working in the field as well as strengthens association activities and the members' own professional identity.

The experts of the OAJ office provide training to shop stewards, association presidents, occupational safety and health operators, regional operators and those taking part in the operations of OAJ and its associations. Remote training events and webinars are organised more and more often and the selection of training offered directly to members is growing in line with OAJ's members' wishes.

Entering working life and starting to work as a teacher is a big change.

OAJ offers the popular NOPE training to those beginning their professional life as a teacher. The training is intended for teachers who have worked in the field for less than five years and are under 35 years of age. The abbreviation 'NOPE' comes from the Finnish words nuori opettaja (young teacher).

OAJ's member associations organise training for their own employees and members. These local and regional member training events are intended for all members of the associations in question. Training is an important membership benefit.

**AS A MEMBER** of the union, you are entitled to Turva's travel insurance, luggage and travel liability insurance and are also insured against accidents. Travel insurance also covers accompanying children under the age of 2O as well as accompanying close relatives living permanently in the same household as the insured. When attending OAJ's events, you are covered by the union insurance against any personal and material damage.

**OAJ WANTS** to strengthen and increase participation and interaction. 

**TEACHER STUDENTS** CAN join the Teacher Student Union of Finland SOOL during their studies. SOOL takes care of the advocacy of teacher students on a national level and trains and unites all teachers-to-be. You can become a member through a member association. If a student cannot join any of the member associations, they can become an individual member.

Apart from unemployment security, the members of SOOL get the same membership benefits as actual OAJ members in addition to the membership benefits of their student association.

More instructions and information related to the student unemployment fund membership, substitute teaching, job search and entering working life can be obtained from the websites of SOOL and OAJ. A student who has worked as a substitute teacher for at least one term during their studies can become a member of OAJ directly. Once the OAJ membership begins, the membership of SOOL is automatically terminated; however, all membership benefits and the potential unemployment fund membership remain valid.

# Membership information and union payments



Up-to-date information guarantees that you receive our electronic membership newsletters containing current information about the association and membership benefits. You can log in to the Omat tiedot section on our website to ensure that your information is up to date in our register. You can also check that your union fees have been paid.

Your union fee varies according to the membership payment of your own member association and is approximately 1.2 per cent of your gross earnings subject to tax. For instance, you will pay a fixed, lower union fee during parental or study leave.

You should make sure to pay your union fees in time because, for instance, the validity of membership benefits and receiving earnings-related daily allowance requires all your union fee payments to be up to date. If your employer deducts your union fees directly from your salary, make sure to check your pay slip to see that the fees have been deducted. If you notice any issues with the union fee payments, make sure to update your payments immediately or contact our member services.
